Traffic Stop Results in Cocaine Charges

On June 29th, 2025, Wautoma Police stopped Ashley Schwabe for traveling 49 miles per hour in a 25 mile per hour speed zone.

Aside from traveling at almost twice the posted speed limit, Schwabe was found to be transporting cocaine and cannabis and placed under arrest.

Wautoma Officers located a quantity of drugs in the vehicle, totaling over 120 grams. Schwabe advised during an interview that she has transported the drugs through Waushara County over 100 times in the past. Schwabe stated this is the first time she has been caught during the 10 hour round trip.

Charges were referred to the Waushara County District Attorney for Possession of Cocaine and Possession of THC.
